How To Reduce Conflicts With Others

Message 3
Philippians 2:1-8, NKJV

2 Therefore if *there is* any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, **2** fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind. **3** *Let* nothing *be done* through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. **4** Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. **5** Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, **6** who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, **7** but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men. **8** And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of death*, even the death of the cross. Phil 2:1-8, NKJV

FIVE PRACTICAL STEPS THAT CAN HELP US REDUCE CONFLICT WITH OTHER PEOPLE!

Defuse Competition - 2:3a - Let nothing be done through selfish ambition - strife

Where do you think all these appalling wars and quarrels come from? Do you think they just happen? Think again. They come about because you want your own way, and fight for it deep inside yourselves. You lust for what you don't have and are willing to kill to get it. You want what isn't yours and will risk violence to get your hands on it. James 4:1-2, MSG

#1 Cause of Conflict is Competing Desires!

Delete Conceit - 2:3b - or conceit - vain glory

By pride comes nothing but strife, But with the well-advised *is* wisdom. Proverbs 13:10, NKJV

Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18, ESV

Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall. 1 Corinthians 10:12, NKJV

#2 Cause of Conflict is Personal Pride!

Decrease Criticism - 2:3c - but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

“Some people, without knowing it, carry with them a magnifying glass, with which to see, when they wish, other people’s imperfections.” John Wanamaker

#3 Cause of Conflict is when I fail to value other people!

Demonstrate Consideration - 2:4 - Let each of you look out not only for his own interest, but also for the interest of others.

Husbands, likewise, dwell with *them* with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as *being* heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered. 1 Peter 3:7, NKJV

#4 Cause of Conflict is when I’m insensitive to other’s needs!

Develop Christ-Likeness - 2:5 - Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus

2:6 - He didn’t demand His Rights!

2:7 - He had a serving Attitude!

2:8 - He was willing to sacrifice Himself for the Blessing and the Benefit of Others!

#5 Cause of Conflict is Living without Jesus Christ!
