CONQUERING COMPLAINING

Message 5
Philippians 2:14-16, NKJV

¹⁴ Do all things without complaining and disputing, ¹⁵ that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, ¹⁶ holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain. *Philippians 2:14-16, NKJV*

Four Types of Complainers

◆ **The Whiner** - Favorite Phrase - "Life Is Not Fair"

¹¹ And when they had received *it*, they complained against the landowner, ¹² saying, 'These last *men* have worked *only* one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.' *Matthew 20:11-12, NKJV*

◆ **The Martyr** - Favorite Phrase - "No One Appreciates Me"

So Moses said to the Lord, "Why have You afflicted Your servant? And why have I not found favor in Your sight, that You have laid the burden of all these people on me?" *Numbers 11:11, NKJV*

◆ **The Cynic** - Favorite Phrase - "Nothing Will Ever Change"

Nothing makes sense! Everything is nonsense. I have seen it all—nothing makes sense! *Ecclesiastes 1:2, CEV (Contemporary English Version)*

◆ **The Perfectionist** - Favorite Phrase - "Is That The Best You Can Do"

A continual dripping on a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike; *Proverbs 27:15, NKJV*

How Do We Conquer Complaining?

◆ **Admit that it is a problem**

He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy.
Proverbs 28:13, NKJV

◆ **Accept responsibility for my own life**

The foolishness of a man twists his way, and his heart frets against the LORD. *Proverbs 19:3, NKJV*

◆ **Develop an attitude of gratitude**

In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. *1 Thessalonians 5:18, NKJV*

◆ **Look for God's hand in circumstances**

¹⁷For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding *and* eternal weight of glory, ¹⁸while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen *are* temporary, but the things which are not seen *are* eternal. *2 Corinthians 4:17-18, NKJV*

◆ **Practice speaking positively**

Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
Proverbs 18:21, NKJV
