GREATER IS HE!

**The Holy Spirit and the Apostles
Message 2**

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them,
because HE WHO IS IN YOU IS GREATER than he who is in the world.
1 John 4:4, NKJV

Our goal is for all of us to experience, enjoy and express more of the Holy Spirit in and through our lives to impact our culture, community, city and world with the transforming power of the gospel of Jesus Christ!

Three Changes That Transformed Ordinary Men Into Extraordinary Men

1. Human Weaknesses Were Transformed Into Supernatural Abilities And Gifts!

2 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. ²And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them. ⁴And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. *Acts 2:1-4, NKJV*

3 Now Peter and John went up together to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth *hour*. ²And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms from those who entered the temple; ³who, seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple, asked for alms. ⁴And fixing his eyes on him, with John, Peter said, "Look at us." ⁵So he gave them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. ⁶Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." ⁷And he took him by the right hand and lifted *him* up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. ⁸So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them—walking, leaping, and praising God. *Acts 3:1-8, NKJV*

2. Fearful Reluctance Was Transformed Into Bold Confidence!

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, raised his voice and said to them, "Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and heed my words. *Acts 2:14, NKJV*

And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." *Acts 2:40, NKJV*

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus. *Acts 4:13, NKJV*

²⁷ And when they had brought them, they set *them* before the council. And the high priest asked them, ²⁸saying, "Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this Man's blood on us!" ²⁹ But Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men. ³⁰ The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you murdered by hanging on a tree. ³¹ Him God has exalted to His right hand *to be* Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. ³² And we are His witnesses to these things, and *so* also *is* the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him." *Acts 5:27-32, NKJV*

3. Lonely Feelings Of Abandonment Were Transformed Into Joyful Perseverance!

³³ When they heard *this*, they were furious and plotted to kill them. ³⁴ Then one in the council stood up, a Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the law held in respect by all the people, and commanded them to put the apostles outside for a little while. ³⁵ And he said to them: "Men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what you intend to do regarding these men. ³⁶ For some time ago Theudas rose up, claiming to be somebody. A number of men, about four hundred, joined him. He was slain, and all who obeyed him were scattered and came to nothing. ³⁷ After this man, Judas of Galilee rose up in the days of the census, and drew away many people after him. He also perished, and all who obeyed him were dispersed. ³⁸ And now I say to you, keep away from these men and let them alone; for if this plan or this work is of men, it will come to nothing; ³⁹ but if it is of God, you cannot overthrow it—lest you even be found to fight against God." ⁴⁰ And they agreed with him, and when they had called for the apostles and beaten *them*, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. ⁴¹ So they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for His name. ⁴² And daily in the temple, and in every house, they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus *as* the Christ. *Acts 5:33-42, NKJV*

¹² Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; ¹³ but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. *1 Peter 4:12-13, NKJV*

PREPARE FOR COMMUNION:

- ◆ Thank God for the gift of His Son and for His Spirit.
- ◆ Repent of any known sin that is grieving the Holy Spirit.
- ◆ Seek God's forgiveness and cleansing from your sin.
- ◆ Ask God to fill you with the Holy Spirit that will transform you from the inside out.
- ◆ Next week anytime you are tempted, or feel overwhelmed, whisper or shout these words:
"GREATER IS HE THAT IS IN ME THAN HE THAT IS IN THE WORLD!"
