**The Holy Spirit and the Bible and Prayer
Message 3**

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them,
because HE WHO IS IN YOU IS GREATER than he who is in the world.

1 John 4:4, NKJV

Our goal is for all of us to experience, enjoy and express more of the Holy Spirit in and through our lives to impact our culture, community, city and world with the transforming power of the gospel of Jesus Christ!

The Holy Spirit and The Holy Bible!

- ◆ **Revelation** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit spoke to 40 human writers of the Bible the message He wanted them to transmit.
²¹ For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. *2 Peter 1:21, NIV*
- ◆ **Inspiration** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit guided the very pen of these 40 writers so that the spoken message would be accurately written.
¹⁶ All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
2 Tim 3:16-17, NIV
- ◆ **Illumination** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit takes the written Word when it is read and preached and enlightens those human ears and eyes who will hear and see it.
⁹ However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived" - the things God has prepared for those who love him - ¹⁰ these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God.
1 Corinthians 2:9-10, NIV
- ◆ **Application** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit empowers the reader / listener to obey and put into practice the truth of God's Word.
²² Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. *James 1:22, NIV*
- ◆ **Transformation** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit changes the read / listener from the inside out more into the likeness of Jesus Christ.
¹⁸ And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. *2 Corinthians 3:18, NIV*

The Holy Spirit and The Holy Place!

²⁶ In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. *Romans 8:26, NIV*

²⁰ But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, ²¹ keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life. *Jude 20-21, NIV*

- ◆ **Adoration** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit inspires us to worship God for who He is.
²⁴ God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth." *John 4:24, NIV*

- ◆ **Confession** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit convicts us and leads us to repentance and brokenness over the sin that grieves God's heart.
¹⁰ Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. *2 Corinthians 7:10, NIV*

- ◆ **Thanksgiving** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit prompts us to give praise to God for all that He has given and done for us.
¹⁵ One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. ¹⁶ He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷ Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? ¹⁸ Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" *Luke 17:15-18, NIV*

- ◆ **Supplication** - The process whereby the Holy Spirit helps us to pray for ourselves and for others.
¹⁶ Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. *Hebrews 4:16, NIV*
