The Word of Forgiveness!

Message 1 – Luke 23:32-38, NKJV

If you only had six hours to live, what words do you think you would say?

³²There were also two others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death. ³³And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left. ³⁴Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots. ³⁵And the people stood looking on. But even the rulers with them sneered, saying, "He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ, the chosen of God." ³⁶The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine, ³⁷and saying, "If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself." ³⁸And an inscription also was written over Him in letters of Greek, Latin, and Hebrew:

THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

JESUS CAME TO DIE TO PAY FOR OUR GUILT

- Who was Jesus praying for?
- Was His prayer answered?

WHAT WE NORMALLY DO WITH OUR GUILT

- We Bury it!
 - ⁴ For day and night your hand was heavy on me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer.
 - ⁵ Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD." And you forgave the guilt of my sin. *Psalm 32:4-5, NIV*
- We Blame others!

A person's own folly leads to their ruin, yet their heart rages against the LORD. Proverbs 19:3, NIV

- We Beat ourselves up!
 - ⁴My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear. ⁵My wounds fester and are loathsome because of my sinful folly. ⁶I am bowed down and brought very low; all day long I go about mourning. *Psalm 38:4-6, NIV*

WHAT GOD WANTS US TO DO WITH OUR GUILT

- He wants us to admit our guilt!
 Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy. Proverbs 28:13, NIV
- He wants us to ask for forgiveness!
 - He wants us to ask Him for forgiveness.
 - ¹³"But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, 'God, have mercy on me, a sinner.' ¹⁴"I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted." *Luke 18:13-14, NIV*
 - He wants us to ask others for forgiveness.
 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.
 The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. *James 5:16, NIV*
 - He wants us to accept His gift of grace!
 Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. Romans 3:19, NKJV
 - ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, *Romans 3:23-24, NKJV*

We end the way we started, with a sobering question:

If you only had six hours to live, what words do you think you would say?

"I know that Jesus paid my sin debt in full on the cross. I know that I have repented of my sin and I have received Jesus as my personal Lord and Savior. I know that all my sins have been forgiven and forgotten forever. I know that God is my Father, and that heaven is my home. Please promise me that you will meet me there!"
