It Was A Spiritual Thirst!

- ⁵ Jesus arrived at the Samaritan village of Sychar, near the field that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. ^{6–8} Wearied by his long journey, he sat on the edge of Jacob's well, and sent his disciples into the village to buy food, for it was already afternoon.
