BRANCHING OUT
John 15:1-17, NKJV

The Vine - vs 1a

"I am the true vine, ..."

The Vinedresser - vs 1b

"... and My Father is the vinedresser."

The Branches - vs 2-6

² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. ³ You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

⁵ "I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw *them* into the fire, and they are burned.

The Fruit - vs 8, 16

⁸ By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

¹⁶ You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

The Fruit Of Answered Prayer - vs 7

⁷ If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

The Fruit Of Obedient Love - vs 9-10

⁹ "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. ¹⁰ If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

The Fruit Of Inexhaustible Joy - vs 11

¹¹ "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and *that* your joy may be full.

The Fruit Of Sacrificial Love - vs 12-13, 17

¹² This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

¹⁷ These things I command you, that you love one another.

The Fruit Of Intimate Friendship - vs 14-15

¹⁴ You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. ¹⁵ No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

Read this week John 15 and think about one promise that deepens your relationship with Jesus and other people.

Branching Out:

Read this week Matthew 7:15-20 and think about what Jesus meant when He said in verse 20 "Therefore by their fruits, you will know them."
