The Chosen - 12 Ordinary Men

Message 3 - Andrew

When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus. *Acts 4:13, NIV*

- **The Circumstances of Andrew** - John 1:35-40, NKJV

³⁵ Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples. ³⁶ And looking at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God!"

³⁷ The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. ³⁸ Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following, said to them, "What do you seek?"

They said to Him, "Rabbi" (which is to say, when translated, Teacher), "where are You staying?"

³⁹ He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where He was staying, and remained with Him that day (now it was about the tenth hour).

⁴⁰ One of the two who heard John *speak*, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

- ◆ His Family
- ◆ His Fishing
- ◆ His Following

Much of the world idolizes the powerful, the rich, the beautiful, the athletic.

Few are those who follow godly people, but Andrew was one of those rare ones who did!

- **The Compassion of Andrew** - John 1:41-42, NKJV

⁴¹ He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated, the Christ). ⁴² And he brought him to Jesus. Now when Jesus looked at him, He said, "You are Simon the son of Jonah. You shall be called Cephas" (which is translated, A Stone).

- ◆ The Seeking of his brother
- ◆ The Speaking to his brother

Andrew's greatest deed reported in Scripture was bringing Peter, his brother, to the Lord!

Andrew had great compassion for the soul and eternal destiny of his brother!

- **The Calculating by Andrew** - John 6:1-9, NKJV

6 After these things Jesus went over the Sea of Galilee, which is *the Sea* of Tiberias. ² Then a great multitude followed Him, because they saw His signs which He performed on those who were diseased. ³ And Jesus went up on the mountain, and there He sat with His disciples. ⁴ Now the Passover, a feast of the Jews, was near. ⁵ Then Jesus lifted up *His* eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him, He said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?" ⁶ But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He would do. ⁷ Philip answered Him, "Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may have a little." ⁸ One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him, ⁹ ***"There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish, but what are they among so many?"***

- ◆ Andrew noticed the lad
- ◆ Andrew notified the Lord
- ◆ Andrew nullified the lunch

That which determines our usefulness for Christ is not the size of our lunch but our surrender.

It is not how big we are but how big God is that determines what God can do.

Do not underestimate the power of the Lord Jesus Christ!
