Deuteronomy 8:1-15
Luke 22:17-22

⁸ “Every commandment which I command you today you must be careful to observe, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers. ² And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you *and* test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not. ³ So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every *word* that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD. ⁴ Your garments did not wear out on you, nor did your foot swell these forty years. ⁵ You should know in your heart that as a man chastens his son, so the LORD your God chastens you. *Deuteronomy 8:1-5, NKJV*

Remembering What Happened 20 Years Ago That Changed America Forever!

Tuesday, 11 September 2001, began as a normal day. In both New York City and Washington, DC, the morning weather was sunny and clear. Students went to school, workers went to the office, and about 17,000 people commuted to their jobs at the World Trade Center!

And that’s when 19 militants associated with the Islamic extremist group of al-Qaeda hijacked four airplanes and carried out suicide attacks against targets in the United States.

Two of the planes were flown into the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City, a third plane hit the Pentagon just outside of Washington, DC and the fourth plan crashed in Shanksville, PA. Almost 3,000 people were killed during the 9/11 attacks, which triggered major US initiatives to combat terrorism and defined the presidency of George W. Bush.
