Jeremy Samek serves as Senior Counsel with Pennsylvania Family Institute and the Independence Law Center. His legal and legislative efforts have focused on the preservation of religious liberty, protecting human life, strengthening the family, and the elimination of human trafficking. Samek believes that religious liberty is the cornerstone of all freedoms

Before coming to Pa Family, he was an attorney at Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott, LLC, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, representing clients in federal and state courts in commercial litigation, consumer protection, OSHA, US Customs, and product liability disputes. Jeremy was also a Staff Sergeant in the United States Air Force Reserve, working in the Air Transportation Logistics field. He deployed to Kuwait in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and to Kyrgyzstan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

Jeremy received his J.D. from the University of Pittsburgh School of Law in 2006, where he served as an articles editor for the University of Pittsburgh Law Review. He earned his B.A. from Liberty University, magna cum laude in 2003. Jeremy and his wife have five children.
