A Psalm of David.

¹⁰³ Bless the LORD, O my soul;
And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name!
² Bless the LORD, O my soul,
And forget not all His benefits:
³ Who forgives all your iniquities,
Who heals all your diseases,
⁴ Who redeems your life from destruction,
Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies,
⁵ Who satisfies your mouth with good *things*,
So *that* your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
⁶ The LORD executes righteousness
And justice for all who are oppressed.
⁷ He made known His ways to Moses,
His acts to the children of Israel.
⁸ The LORD *is* merciful and gracious,
Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.
⁹ He will not always strive *with us*,
Nor will He keep *His anger* forever.
¹⁰ He has not dealt with us according to our sins,
Nor punished us according to our iniquities.
¹¹ For as the heavens are high above the earth,
So great is His mercy toward those who fear Him;

¹² As far as the east is from the west,
So far has He removed our transgressions from us.
¹³ As a father pities *his* children,
So the LORD pities those who fear Him.
¹⁴ For He ^{14a} knows our frame;
He remembers that we *are* dust.
¹⁵ As *for* man, his days *are* like grass;
As a flower of the field, so he flourishes.
¹⁶ For the wind passes over it, and it is ^{16a} gone,
And its place remembers it no more.
¹⁷ But the mercy of the LORD *is* from everlasting to everlasting
On those who fear Him,
And His righteousness to children's children,
¹⁸ To such as keep His covenant,
And to those who remember His commandments to do them.
¹⁹ The LORD has established His throne in heaven,
And His kingdom rules over all.

⁴Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.

Praise God For His Renewal! – Isaiah 40:29-31, NKJV

²⁹He gives power to the weak, And to *those who have* no might He increases strength. ³⁰Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, ³¹But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew *their* strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

19 After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, “Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power *belong* to the Lord our God! *Revelation 19:1, NKJV*

For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! ⁷Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.” *Revelation 19:3-7, NKJV*

¹¹Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. ¹²His eyes *were* like a flame of fire, and on His head *were* many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. ¹³He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. ¹⁴And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. ¹⁵Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations.
